





After several decades of significantly increasing global economic, socio-cultural, and political integration, the globalization pendulum is swinging back. But what comes “After Globalization”? The 26 chapters of this volume, originally presented at the Word Society Foundation’s 40th anniversary celebration in 2022, address from different angles four core issues of “deglobalization”: First, the re-conceptualization of world society

and globalization within the current context of deglobalization. Second, the dynamics that are (re)shaping the world-economy, including processes of fragmentation, regionalization, reshoring, and global and regional polarization. 

Fiscal Capacity and Resource Mobilization in Africa New Strategies and New Instruments

Volume 24 (2024/2025) of the African Development Perspectives Yearbook with the title “Fiscal Capacity and Resource Mobilization in Africa – New Strategies and New Instruments” focusses on the issues of fiscal states in Africa, on taxation and resource mobilization, and on strategies to increase the fiscal capacity of African countries. In four Units (parts of the Yearbook volume 24) key issues of fiscal reconstruction in Africa in times of multiple world crises are presented. Unit 1 on General Issues presents in five essays analyses of pre-colonial, colonial and postcolonial taxation systems in Africa, and country case studies (Tunisia, Cameroon, Uganda), but also new instruments and tools for financing social welfare in Africa. Unit 2 presents six essays which are focussing on the fiscal state of Senegal, covering essays on the potentials of how to learn from other African countries to tax, analyses of the tax structure of Senegal, new approaches to streamline the “tax expenditures” in Senegal, and policies for extending the fiscal good governance to local authorities in Senegal. Unit 3 has four contributions on the role of fiscal policy and other policy interventions during the COVID-19 pandemic in Southern Africa, by highlighting the different clusters on COVID-19 in terms of responding to the shock by policy interventions in Africa, by analysing cases of fiscal policy interventions on COVID-19 in the countries of the South African Customs Union (SACU), and by presenting a specific and deep analysis of fiscal interventions in South Africa. Unit 4 presents book reviews and book notes for publications in the context of fiscal states in Africa, but also covers major publications on Africa in the global, regional, capacities. There are reviews and book notes of publications on vital issues of Africa’s development perspectives, and on major global and regional economic development reports. Volume 24 (2024 / 2025) of the African Development Perspectives Yearbook is an important publication as it allows the reader to understand the reactions of African countries to the current situation of polycrisis. Key for these times to become more resilient is the strengthening of domestic resource mobilization.

It is about war in specific conditions of today's Africa, where war seems to be a normal means for achieving political goals. Civil wars multiplied soon after the colonial powers left the scene, when important deposits of mineral wealth were discovered or ethnic composition was preventing equitable development. Another category of armed conflicts are those in which two or more groups within a state compete for hegemony on a particular territory. These conflicts are not really civil wars but conflicts which are not intended to upset the post-colonial state. However they indicate that people involved in them cherish values that might look esoteric to the outsiders.
